The Gospel of Mark is an exciting, short and fast paced narrative of key events from the life of Jesus challenging us to be disciples of Jesus - cultivating a heart for fellowship with Him, trusting Him, confessing Him, observing his conduct and teaching and enjoying all the benefits of relationship with him.
